Aim of the workshop

The workshop will contribute to the conceptualisation and planning of the envisaged European Joint Programming (EJP)-LEAP-RE and validate agendas on Research and Innovation (R&I) and Human and Institutional Capacity Building (HICB) and Organisational and Funding (O&F) principles. Together with relevant stakeholders it will also consolidate the network-building objectives of this work package. Elements of the long-term approach for the AU-EU partnership in RE will be shared, including the Theory of Change and Impact Pathway (TCIP), the Programme & Innovation Cycle (PIMC), as well as the concept of a Knowledge Management and Communication Framework (KMCF) and a draft funding concept. This new partnership will be assisted by valuable lessons learned from existing projects.

Expected Output

- Stakeholders will be informed in detail about PRE-LEAP-RE activities and the options for the envisaged EJP LEAP-RE
- Preparation material of EJP-LEAP-RE for the 1st workshop will have been commented and developed further
- The way forward will have been discussed, including the format and concept of workshop #2
- Suggestions for a coordinating institution of the EJP-LEAP-RE will have been made
